1. What is Golf Scores X

Golf Scores X is a simple to use digital scorecard with optional GPS Rangefinder. It is the newer and improved version of Golf Scores. This app allows the user to record strokes taken, putts and more, and would automatically calculate the score based on the type of round played.

The type of round is defined by choosing:

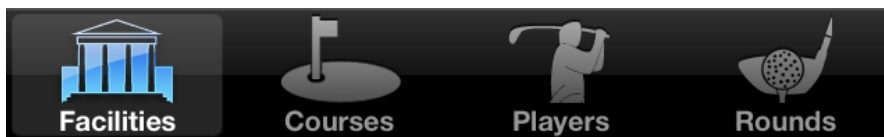
- A scoring system: Stroke Play, Stableford or vs. Par, and
- Optionally, a course/play handicap calculated based on USGA, EGA or UK formula.

2. Navigating the Application

Golf Scores X presents your information grouped in four selectable views located along the bottom of the device display:

- Facilities
- Courses
- Players
- Rounds

By tapping on the selected views, you control what is displayed.






2.1. Facilities View

This view allows the user to manage facilities (Golf Clubs).

- **Adding Facility**

To add Facility tap + and you'll be displayed with three options:

- Download
This option would bring the 'search & download' screen where you can search for the facility and if found tap on it to download. If the facility is not available you can create it on <http://petrovski.net.au/GolfScoresX/facilities.aspx> It would then immediately become available for download.
- Select One from Contacts
This option would bring a screen containing all your contacts . You can then select a contact to represent the facility. This will by default create a facility with one course containing 18 holes and one teebox. Configure this course using the in app course editor.

- Create New One
This option is the similar to the above, but instead of selecting an existing contact you will create a new contact.
- **Managing existing Facility**
Tap on the facility name then *Edit*.
 - To add Course tap  .
 - To delete Course tap  .
 - To delete the facility, scroll down and tap Delete Facility.
- **Viewing Facility Details**
To see the *Facility Info* screen, tap on the facility name.
To view facilities' contact details, tap on the name.
To change measuring units, tap on *Measuring Units*, select *meters* or *yards*.
To view course details, tap on course name.
- **Updating Downloaded Facility**
Tap on  and all the facilities that were downloaded would be updated, if update is available.

Please note that if you have manually (in app) changed or updated facility information such as slope, rating for a teebox or any of the hole details, this would be overwritten with any update downloaded from the Golf Scores X website. Therefore I strongly recommend that you update the facility online and than download the update.

2.2. Courses View

This view would list all the courses that you have in alphabetical order. The facility that the course belongs to is displayed below the course name.

View course details: Tap on the course name and you will see the course info screen where you'll can:

- Change course name: tap on the name.
- View all rounds played on the course by tapping on the Rounds (number of round is displayed in here too).
- View hole details: tap in holes, than tap on the hole number.

2.3. Players View

This view allows you to manage players' details.

- **Adding Player**
To add Player tap + and you'll be displayed with three options:
 - Select One from Contacts – choosing this option would bring a screen containing all your contacts. Select the person that you want to add as player from this list.

- Create New One – choosing this option would allow you to create a new player which would also be included in your contacts.
- **Managing Existing Players**
Tap on player’s name and you will be taken to player’s info screen where you can:

Change players’ contact details: tap on the name.

Change gender: tap on gender.

Change handicap: tap on handicap.

Delete player: tap on *Edit, Delete Player* button.

2.4. Rounds View

This view allows you to manage rounds played, scorecards for each round and each player per round.

- **Adding Round**
To add Round tap +, select the course that this round would be played on. This would take you to ‘Round Info’ screen from where you can:

Change course: tap on the course name.

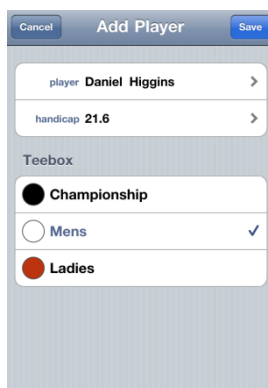
Change the date and time round played (default to current data and time): tap on date.

Select start and end hole: tap on holes.

Select type of round: tap on type and you will be taken to a screen where you can choose type of round played based on scoring system and course handicap.


Scoring System	Course Handicap
Stroke Play	Do not use (net score equals to gross score)
Stableford	Based on USGA formula
vs Par	Based on EGA formula
	Based on UK formula


Add Players: tap on ‘Add Player’ and you’ll be taken to ‘Add Player’ screen where you:



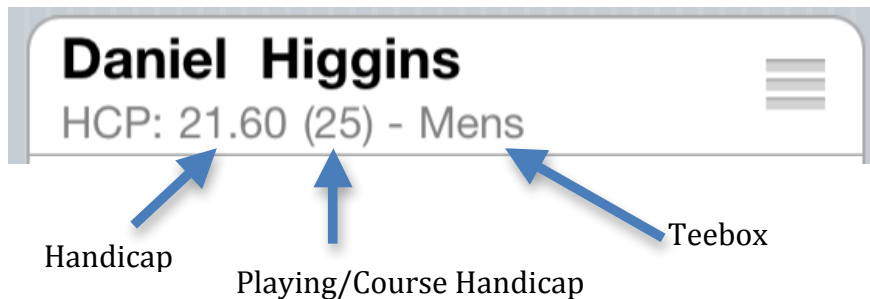
- **Select player:** tap on player, than tap on player’s name.
- **Change player’s handicap:** tap on handicap. Please note that this would only change player’s handicap for this round and not the general handicap. Useful feature that allows you to change player’s handicap even after the round was played for situations where handicap was unknown or incorrect.
- **Select teebox:** tap on the name of the teebox. This determines the slope and rating used to calculate the score (depending on the type of round played).

Change player's handicap and/or teebox: tap on player's name.


Reorder players: tap on  and drag player to desired location.

Remove player: tap on .


Preview player's details for this round:



- **Deleting Rounds**

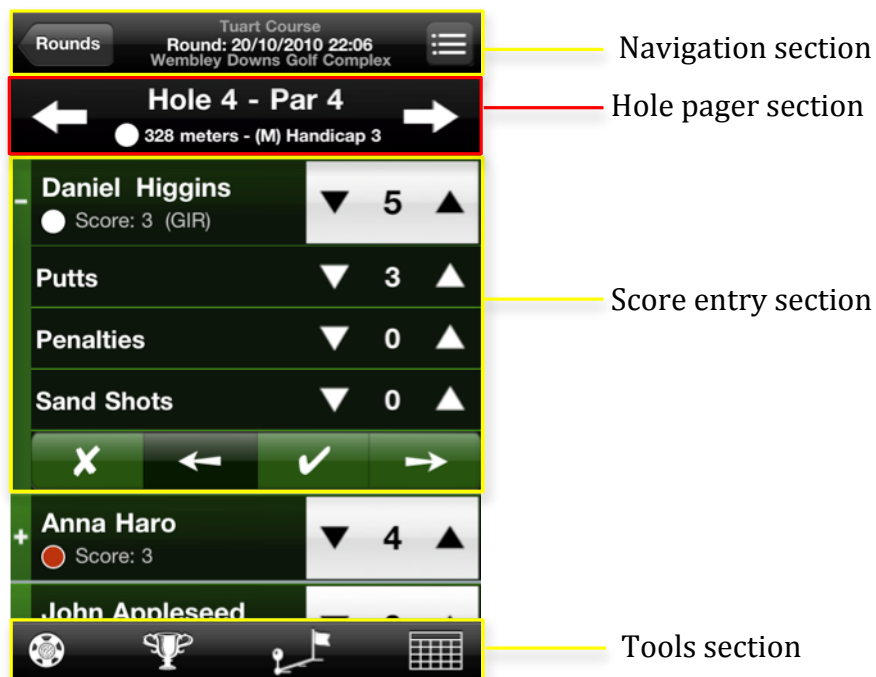
Tap Edit that tap  and finally tap Delete to confirm deletion.

- **Changing Round Details**

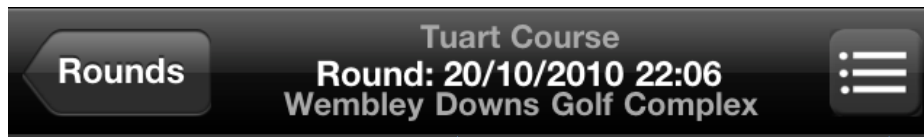
Tap on the date that represents the round, then tap on , from here you edit the round details except the start and end hole. You can also set or remove End Date – set would end round and turn it into read-only.

- **Score Entry**

Once you have added a round via Rounds screen you will be automatically taken to 'Score Entry' screen. Alternatively, go to Rounds screen and tap on the date that represents the round you would like to enter/edit scores.



Navigation section

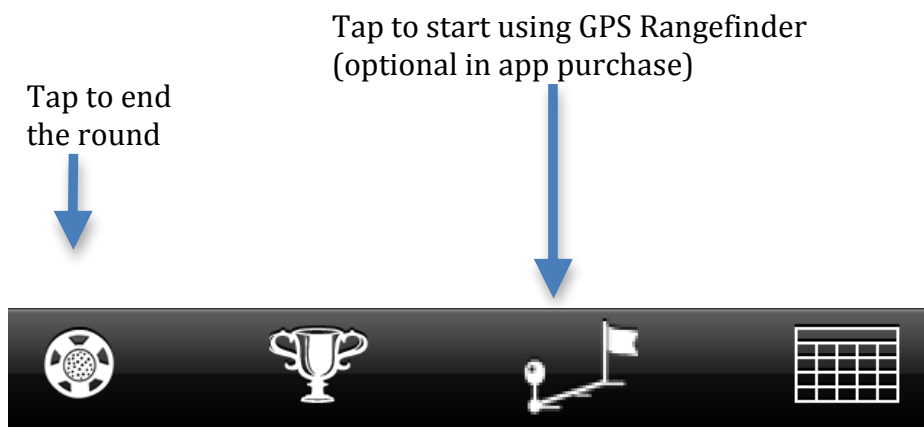


Tap to go back to Rounds screen

Tap to view Round Info screen.

Round related info (in order, top - down): the name of the course the round is played on, round's date and time, the name of the facility the course belongs to.

Tools section



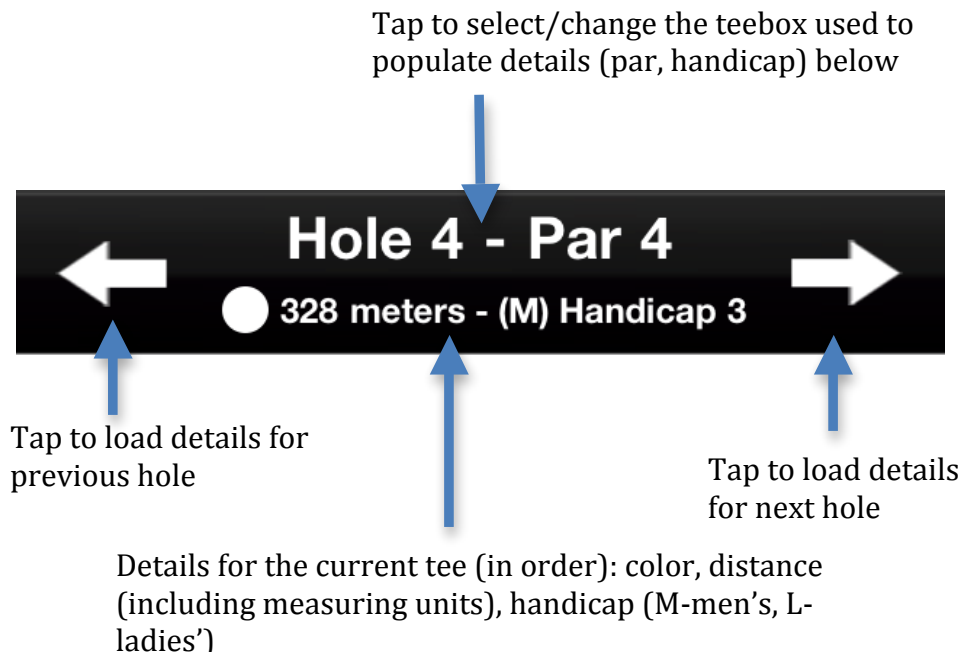
Tap to end the round

Tap to start using GPS Rangefinder (optional in app purchase)

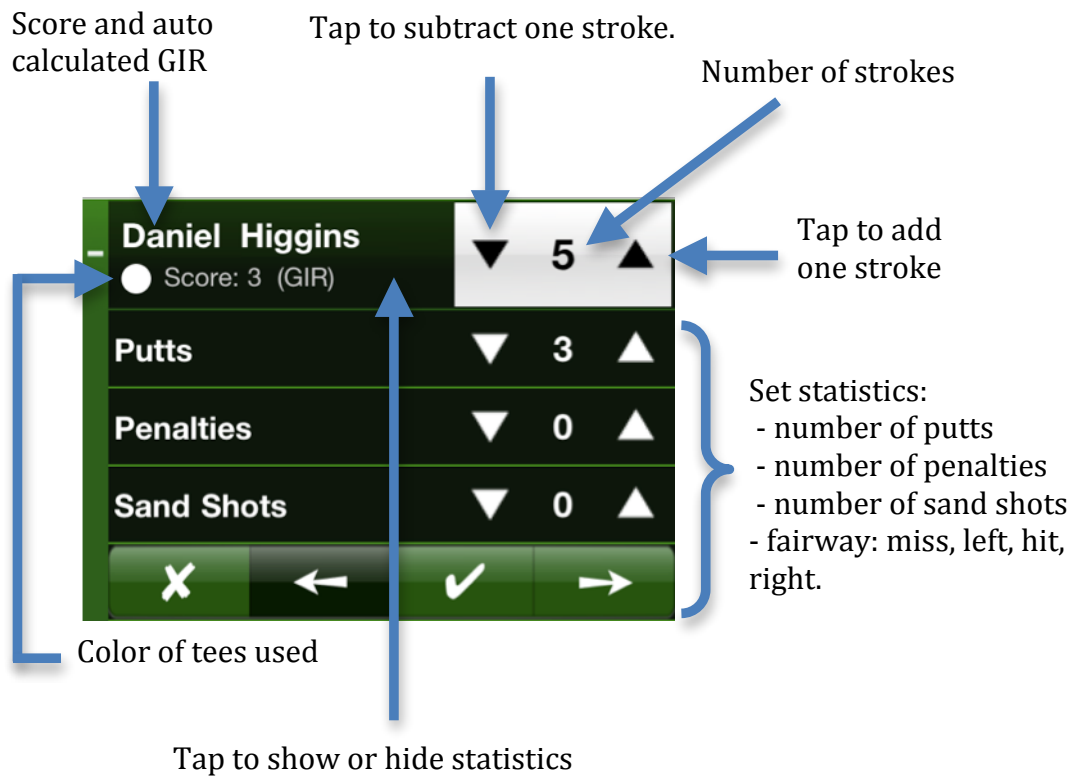
Tap to see Leaderboard

Tap to get info on how to view scorecard(s) - rotate the device in landscape mode.

Score entry section - current hole

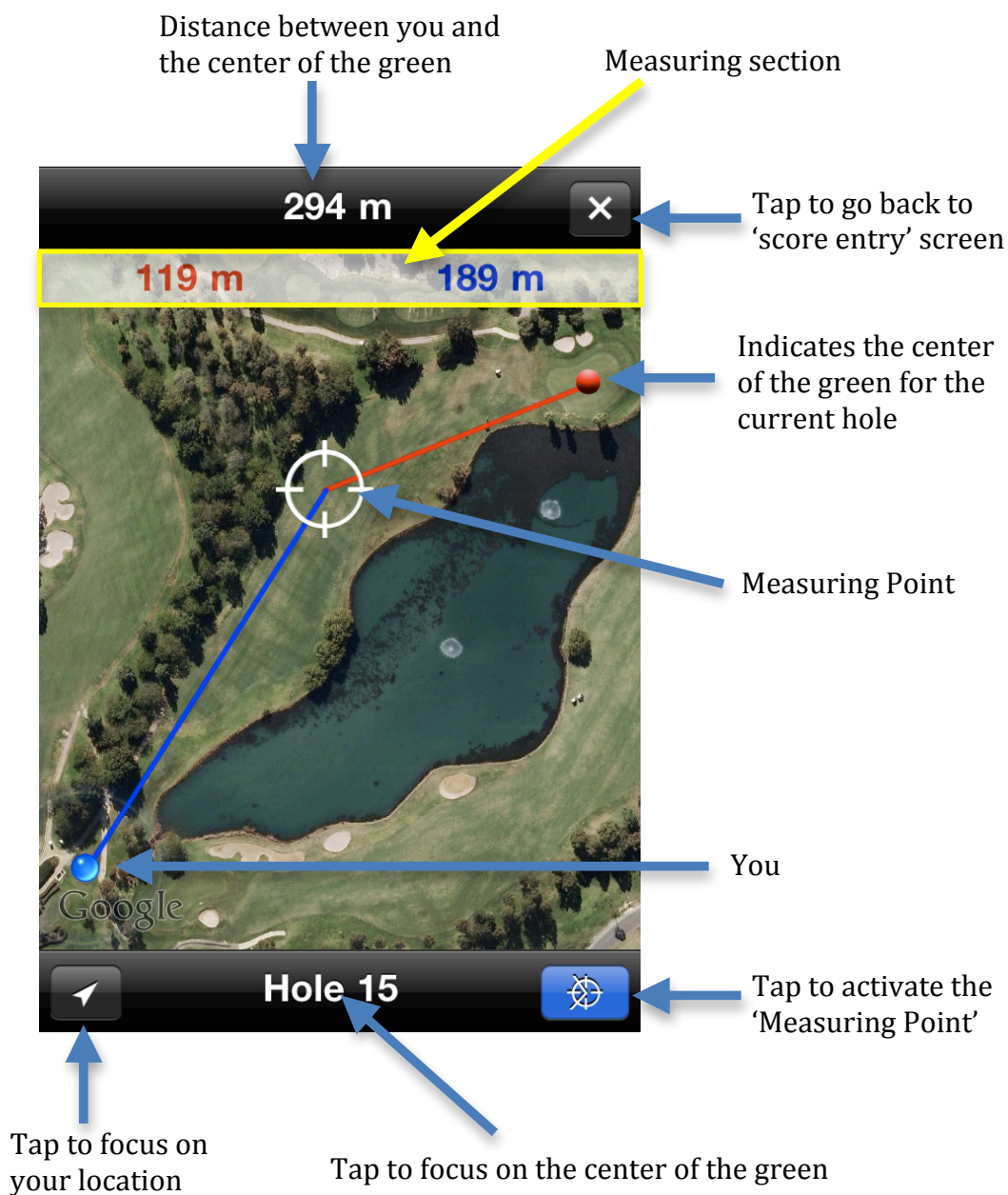


3. Optional features - In App purchase

Golf Scores X currently has only one optional feature that can be activated via in app purchase.

3.1. GPS Rangefinder

GPS Rangefinder helps you determine the distance between you and the centre of the green for the currently played hole. Also, can calculate distance to a point and from the point to the centre of the green - plan your next shot!



Measuring section: the red number (119m) indicated the distance between the 'measuring point' and the center of the green, while the blue number (189m) indicated the distance between you and the 'measuring point'.
